

How to make car wheels look like they are spinning in Adobe Photoshop CS5

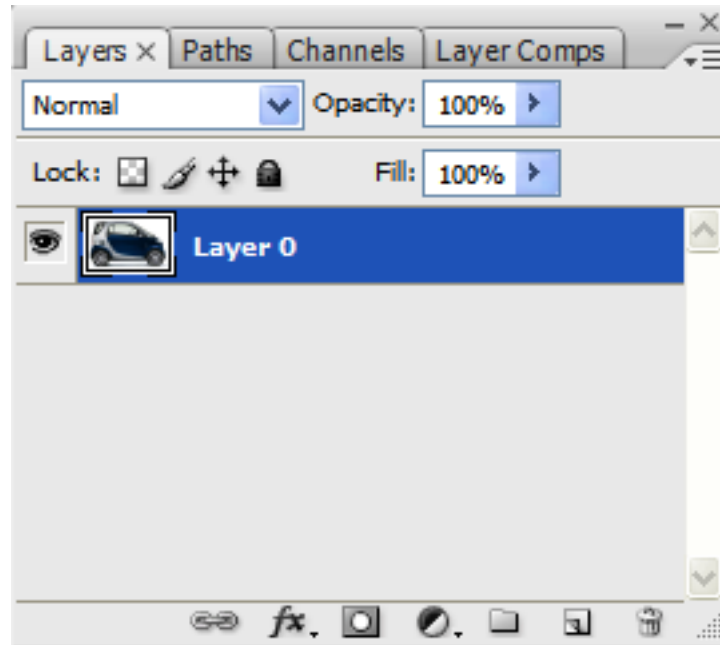

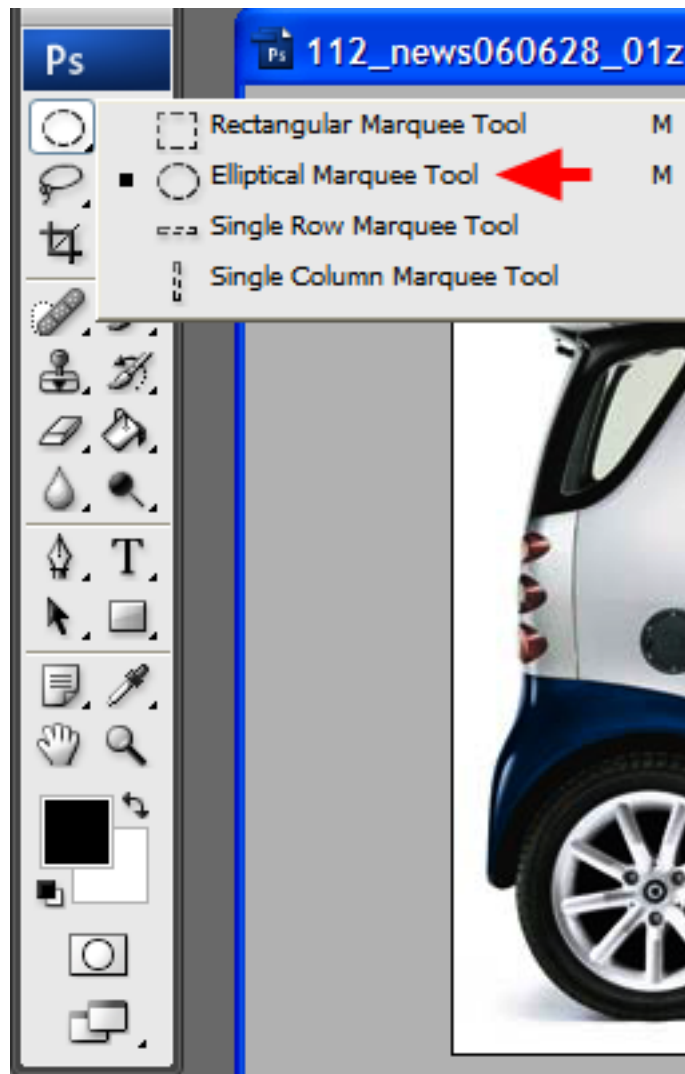
Task Description: How do I make the wheels on a car look like they are spinning?

Select the car layer.



Select the "Elliptical Marquee Tool"

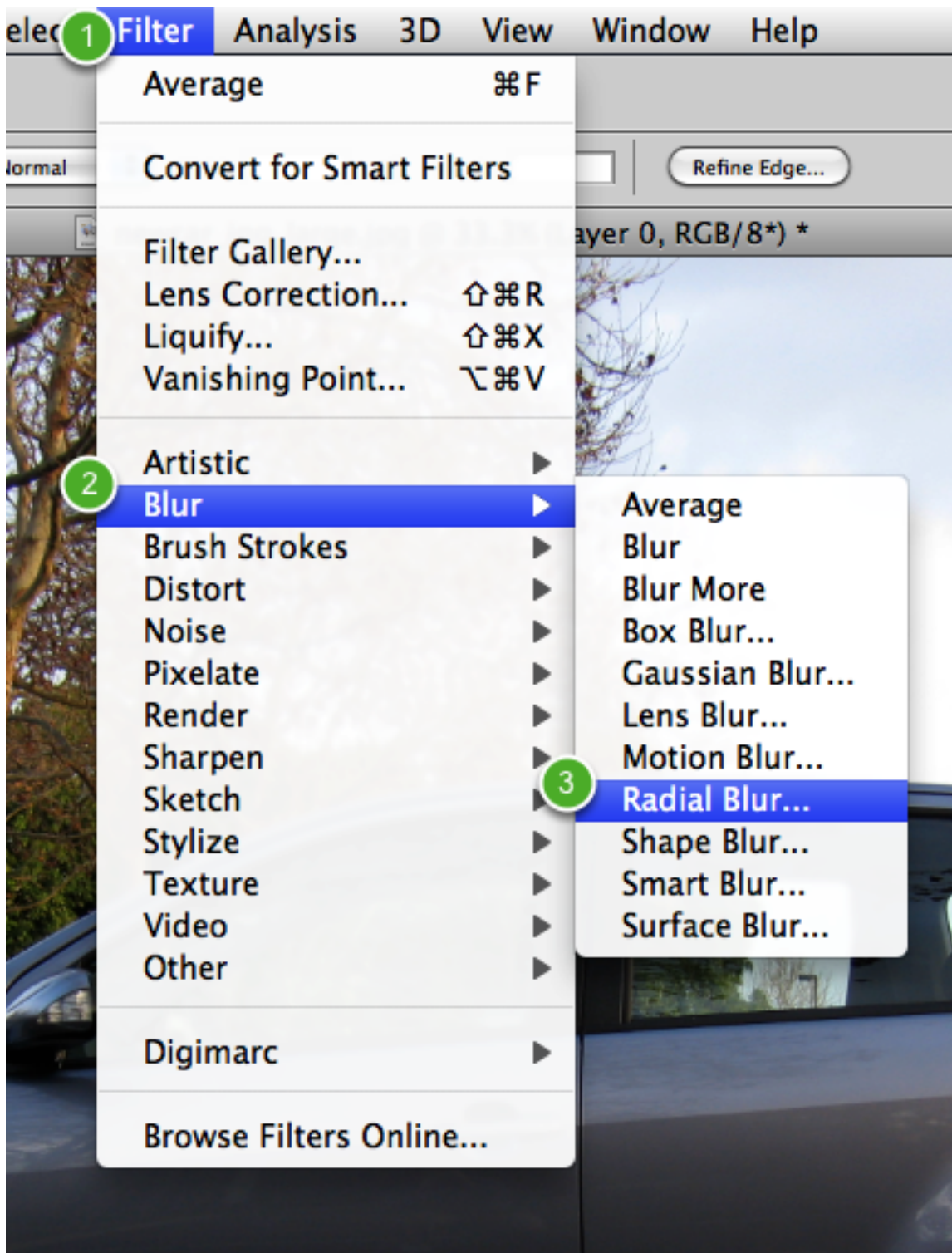


Draw a circle around your rims.

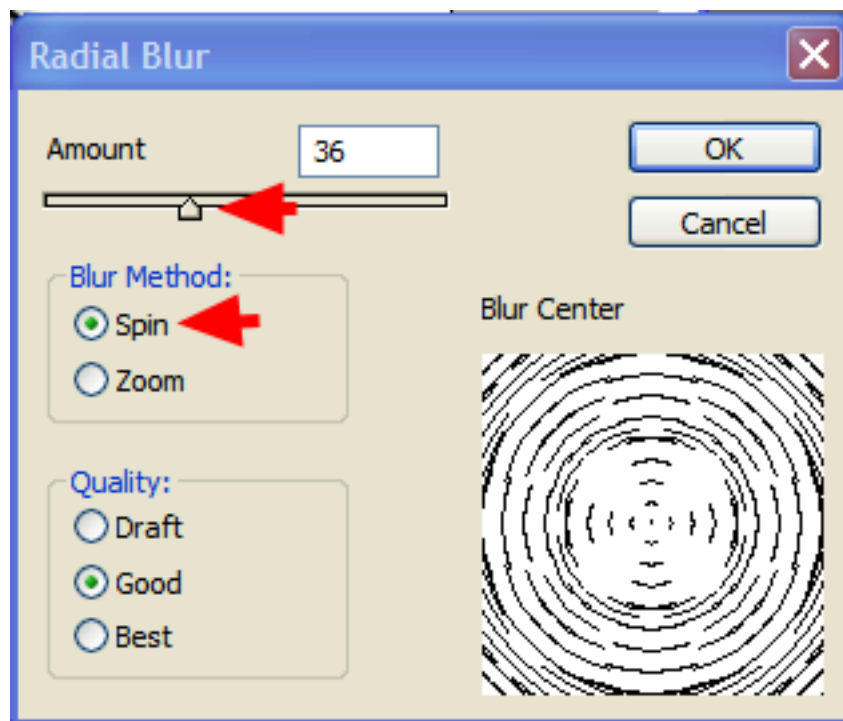


- Hold down "Shift" to make a perfect circle.
- Hold down "Alt" to make the circle grow from the center.

Select "Filter"

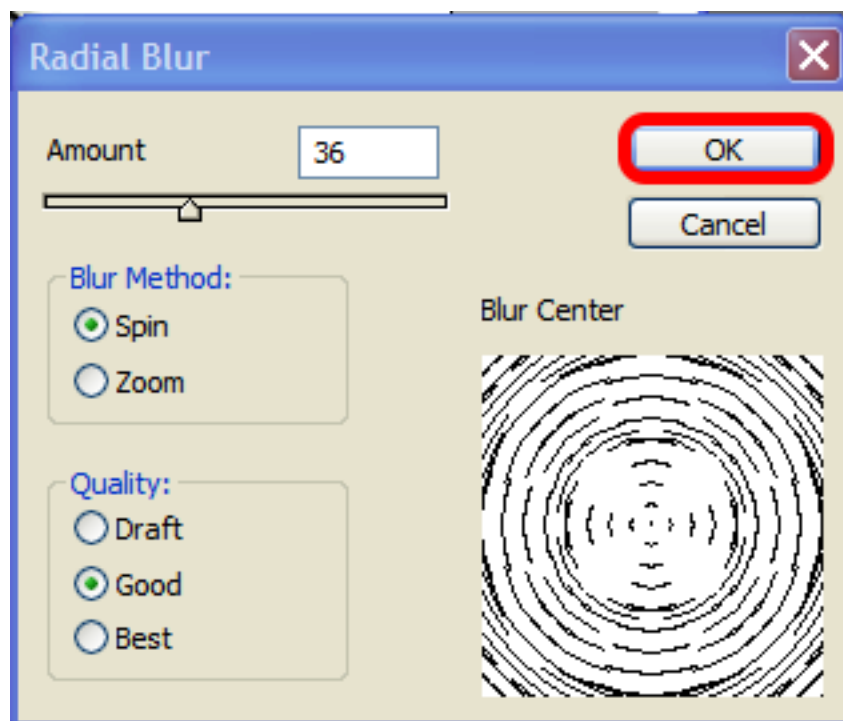


Make Adjustments.



- Make sure that "Spin" is selected.
- Move the "Amount" tab either left or right.
 - * Use around 30 for the "Amount." This will vary for different wheels.

Click on "OK"



Select the other wheel.



Just move the selected circle to the other wheel by clicking and dragging it.

Repeat the steps to blur the wheel.



Filter - Blur - Radial Blur - Click on "OK" (The adjustments should still be the same).

Deselect the wheel.
