

Content Objective: Students analyze and write Haiku poetry that focuses on nature.

Language Objectives: Student will:

- Students will read sample Haiku poems.
- Students will discuss the format and analyze Haiku poems.
- Students will actively listen as poems are read aloud.
- Students will write a Haiku poem.
