4th Grade Reading Lesson Plan

Content Objective: Students will read about the story of Cinderella through the eyes of different cultures and compare and contrast the story in its different contexts.

Language Objectives: Students will

- Read four different versions of the fairy tale Cinderella
- Write about the differences and similarities between the four stories
- Discuss with their group members about the differences and similarities
- Listen to what their group members have to say and provide feedback

Assessment: Read the stories, find similarities and differences between them, and make a conclusion about how culture affects literature
