 Oral Assessment Plan
 Third grade social studies

Content Objective: Students will be able to identify some hardships that the pioneers may have had as well as what may have caused them.

Language Objectives: Students will actively listen as they watch the movie, “Children of the Wagon Train”. They will read a map of the Mormon Trail and predict what hardships could have come to the pioneers while traveling the trail. They will write their predictions down and after we explore the ‘Various Pioneer Hardships’ link they will discuss their predictions in small groups with one another.

Assessment Plan: Students will do a self assessment on how well they listened and participated in the discussion groups. They will do this by doing a quick write answering three questions: 1: On a scale of 1-10, how well did I listen and participate during the movie and discussion? 2: Describe some hardships the pioneers went through. 3: Describe something new that you learned today.

<p>Level C Intermediate</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide a guided notes sheet during the movie. • Some materials in their L1. • Lots of use of pictures and visuals. • Encourage discussion in English.
<p>Levels D&E Advanced; Fluent</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide guided notes during the movie. • Use of a variety of maps and visuals. • Discuss in English.
